## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE FILE/S SEP22-006

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL**: The City of Pacific (Pacific) proposes to implement motorized and non-motorized projects for its transportation system as presented in the 2023-2028 Six Year Transportation Plan (STIP). The 2023-2028 STIP is the long-range, transportation system plan that is required by the Washington Department of Transportation annually. The 2023-2028 STIP describes the proposed motorized and non-motorized projects, including estimated costs and proposed year of phase implementation. The proposed plan outlines a number of major capital projects and on-going maintenance activities, which could require future environmental review, where applicable, under the phased review provisions of SEPA.

The responsible official of the City of Pacific hereby makes the following determination based upon impacts identified in the Environmental Checklist and the Staff Evaluation for the Environmental Checklist (Case No. SEP22-006), and Conclusions of Law based upon the City of Pacific Comprehensive Plan and EIS, and other Municipal policies, plans, rules and regulations designated as a basis for the exercise of substantive authority of the Washington State Environmental Policy Act Rules pursuant to RCW 43.21C.060. *The responsible official further determines that additional environmental "phased review" as provided for under WAC 197-11-060 (5) may be done regarding the proposed changes.* 

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment, and an environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. The City reserves the right to review any new information, future revisions or alterations to the site or the proposal (WAC 197-11-340) in order to determine the environmental significance or non-significance of the project at that point of time.

Any person wishing to appeal this determination may file such an appeal within <u>Twenty-one (21)</u> days of the end of the comment period to the Dept. of Community Development, located at 100 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE. All appeals of the above determination must be filed by **5:00 P.M. <u>July 1, 2022</u>**. Appeals shall be submitted pursuant to Pacific Municipal Code Section 16.16.260. **THERE IS A \$1,000.00 FEE TO APPEAL THIS DETERMINATION.**
