

The City has received a \$92,000 grant from the Recreation Conservation Office for the purchase and installation of new parks benches, picnic tables and Engineered Wood Fiber for several parks. Parks include: Rhubarb, Beaver, Steiger, Otter, Elise, Sunset and Blueberry.

Work has also begun on the replacement of the play structure at Milwaukee Park. Demo of old structure has been completed and installation of new structure should take place in January.
