DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE FILE SEP-23-001/SDP-23-004 Tavitian Gravel Surfacing Project

DATE OF NOTICE: August 17th, 2023

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: To gravel approximately 12,800 square feet of level, cleared land for dry commercial open storage. Drainage will be provided by an engineer-designed on-site infiltration trench along the north property edge of the new gravel area. The site has an existing older residence with yard area which will remain and not be disturbed. The total area of the site is 20,875 square feet. There will be 625 cubic yards of cut and 625 cubic yards of fill for a total of 1,250 cubic yards of cut and fill.
