DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE FILE SEP-23-002 Beaver Dam Removal

DATE OF NOTICE: June 30th, 2023

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: The City of Pacific proposes to remove a beaver dam on Milwaukee Creek using a backhoe. Dam removal will follow the guidance provided in Washington Administrative Code 220-660-230 and the conditions of HPA 2022-9-13+01, Beaver Dam Removal and Modification in WSDOT right-of-way. The backhoe will be parked adjacent to the creek and the arm and bucket used to remove the dam.
